## PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Adventurer Club is a church sponsored ministry open to all children ages 4–9, in which the church, home and school join together to help children grow joyfully in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and man. Gracepoint Adventurer Club will meet on the 2nd Sabbath of the month from 2:00 – 3:30 p.m.

- Club activities include Adventurer Awards, field trips, and regular club meetings. The Adventurer must agree to participate and cooperate in these activities.
- Members must be faithful in attendance.
- The parents of the Adventurers must agree to and cooperate with the regulations and activities of the club. The parents will support Adventurer club activities by participating in the classroom and in other activities and by reinforcing learning at home.
- Adventurers should own and regularly wear a complete Adventurer uniform (approximately \$40 for both Class A and field uniforms). They must attend meetings and club-sponsored events in full uniform, as advised by the club director.
- Adventurers are expected to obey all regulations and instructions of the Adventurer staff.
- Club members must be willing to participate in community service projects and Share Your Faith and Outreach programs.
- Adventurers must learn and live by the principles of the Adventurer Pledge and Law.

## UNIFORM INFO & T-SHIRT ORDER

Adventurers should have both Class A and field uniforms.

### Class A Uniform

The Class A uniform consists of the following items (available for purchase at [adventsource.org](http://adventsource.org)):

Blue Adventurer Club Shirt (boy or girl)

Award Sash

Uniform Scarf

Uniform Slide

Uniform Patch

World Patch

Class A uniform items are to be paired with navy blue bottoms, navy blue socks, and black shoes. This uniform is worn when Adventurers perform at church, at induction and investiture ceremonies, and any other more formal events. The events when the Class A uniform is required is noted on the schedule.



### Field Uniform

The field uniform consists of a Gracepoint Adventurer Club T-shirt with jeans or shorts. Our club T-shirt is included in the registration fee.

### Patches

The official correct placement of the patches is as follows. However, on the smaller shirts, there is not enough room on the sleeve to follow this placement, so you may sew the patches centered top to bottom on the appropriate sleeve.

- The Adventurer Patch: right sleeve (2.5 inches from shoulder).

- The Adventurer World: left sleeve (1.5 inches from shoulder).
